

Pia's Welcome To San Francisco

A 32 Bar Strathspey for 2 Couples

- Bars 1 – 4 First couple set and cross giving right hands.
- Bars 5 – 8 First woman and second man and first man and second woman set and link on the sides.
- Bars 9 – 10 Second woman and first man, second man and first woman turn with both hands. (The person with whom you just completed the set and link.)
- Bars 11 – 14 Second and first couples circle four hands round to the left.
- Bars 15 – 16 Second and first couples turn partner with both hands.
- Bars 17 – 24 Second and first couples dance Ladies' Chain.
- Bars 25 – 28 Second and first couple advance and retire.
- Bars 29 – 32 First couple turns 1½ times with both hands to own side ready to repeat the dance.

Notes: Bars 5 – 16 represent the “Kilt Pin Set and Link” as devised by Pia Walker on the Strathspey server following a discussion about kilt pins getting caught. Pia came to San Francisco in July but we did not get a chance to dance.
