

Cell Phone Jig

A 32 Bar Jig for 3 Couples

- Bars 1 – 8 First couple cast off and dance and dance down behind their own line for four skip change of step, turn outward and then dance four steps back to place. (It would be proper to phone one's partner during this figure.)
- Bars 9 – 12 First and second couples dance right hands across.
- Bars 13 – 16 First couple, giving right hands, cross over and cast off one place. Second couple step up on bars 15 and 16.
- Bars 17 – 20 First and third couples dance right hands across.
- Bars 21 – 24 First couple dance a half figure of eight around the second couple.
- Bars 25 – 32 First couple turn first corners with right hands. First couple pass each other by the right shoulder. First couple turn second corners with right hands. First couple passing right shoulders cross to second place on own sides. This is a four bar turn for the corners.

Notes: All dancers have their left hands free to hold their cell phones. This dance was devised as a response to comments on the Strathspey server (www.strathspey.org) about dancers bringing cell phones to class. This dance is also appropriate for anyone with their left arm in a cast.
